STATEMENT BRASILIA

Taking in consideration that:

- That the society of the countries in America faces an important social transformation, which the engineers cannot ignore.
- That the engineers, in every affiliated country, must raise a strong and authorized voice, in front of the facts which all of the segments that the society has to outlive.
- That the transformations demanded by the social movements can affect profoundly the organized structures of our countries, and hence, the acquaintanceship and the conditioning balance of the technic.
- That the proposals and studies that the engineers offer to the society are barely recognized and hardly included, completely, in the public policies.
- That the vision expressed by the engineers in their interactive speech with the factual society in every collective stage, does not establish an imprint in the advised transformations, this fact avoids that the countries incorporate a high level technical-scientific thinking in the public policies.

**Demand** to the countries and Associated States:

1. To establish immediately effective communication routes with the representatives of the engineers in each country to create common working bases with the different authorities.
2. To search and implement short term solutions for the more severe problems faced by inhabitants of the world nowadays. To accomplish this, the Panamerican Engineers are prepared to offer an immediate collaboration.
3. To develop interactive educational systems with innovative and continuous improvement, accomplishing this way, the implementation of agendas incorporating the Engineers in the tasks demanded by the society and its economy.
4. To include, urgently, development schedules, based in researches done by engineers, so they be integrated in public policies containing effective measures to face natural disasters such as, earthquakes, tsunamis, hurricanes, fires and others, especially in the regions of poverty population.
5. To promote the creation of open discussion spaces with the authority, in order to avoid deviations related to the essential role of the engineers in the societies of the countries of America.
6. To persuade the social and political movements, whichever be its ideological statement, that they acknowledge, profoundly, the well doing of the engineers and their contribution to the society, so they do not be obliterated by any other interest incompatible with any healthy evolution of their inhabitant.

These demands have to be delivered to every authority of the countries' members of the COPI-MERA.

The attendants to the Assembly, be obligated to communicate, publish and share these demands in all media which they can contact.
